Terms and Conditions

These terms and conditions set out the basis and process for submitting your photograph(s) for the Bidford and District History Society (BDHS) Photographer of the Year 2022 competition. By registering, you agree that your participation in and any entries you submit to the competition will be subject to these Terms, the Website Terms of Use and Privacy Policy.

In accordance with the GDPR and Data Protection Bill (and any subsequent reiteration of that legislation), BDHS will hold all personal data securely.

1) Permissions

It is your responsibility to ensure that any photograph(s) submitted have been taken with the written consent of anyone who is identifiable from your photograph(s).

You must obtain the consent of any identifiable individual (or parent/guardian if the individual is under 18) to their image being used in connection with your submission(s). You must advise them that their photograph may be published as part of your submission(s) in accordance with these Terms.

You must also obtain consent for any brand names, logos, signs, or car registration plates that appear prominently in your photograph(s). You must retain a physical and/or electronic copy of any such consent.

BDHS accepts no responsibility for injury or death incurred by you or third-party claims arising from your submission(s).

2) Credit and Ownership

Your photograph(s) must be your own work.

BDHS may reproduce any submission(s) for the purposes of marketing, promotion, discussion and education in all media worldwide. Ongoing permission is granted to the BDHS to use submitted images in the context of the competitions and to support the BDHS's broader work.

BDHS will credit any photograph(s) reproduced wherever practicable.

Photographers will retain full copyright over their own work.

3) Entry Conditions

The competition is free to enter.

Entry is open to both BDHS members and non-members.

Each competitor will be able to submit up to three entries only.

The competition entry form will be at <u>www.bidfordhistory.org.uk</u> between the competition entry dates.

Submitted images may not contain any watermarks or signatures.

There is no restriction on colour requirements; the photographer may choose to enter their submission(s) in monochrome and/or colour.

Entries must be submitted in Jpg format with a minimum size of 2400 x 1800 pixels (4.3 megapixels).

Each submitted photograph must be accompanied by a caption of 50 -- 100 words. This should contain details of the location and subject of the photograph as a minimum. A short narrative of what the subject means to you can be included.

To be eligible for a prize you must supply and maintain a valid email address. Entrants who do not supply an active email address may be disqualified.

Competition organisers and their immediate families and competition judges are ineligible from entering the competition.

The decisions of the organisers and BDHS History Photographer of the Year Judging Panel are final.

4) Competition Dates

The BDHS Local History Photographer of the Year 2022 competition will open for submission(s) between 1st January and 14th April 2022.

Your entries must be submitted by midnight on 14th April 2022.

Any photograph(s) used as part of your submission(s) must have been taken on or after 1st January 2021.

The competition winner and runners-up will be notified by 31st May 2022 and formally announced at the June 2022 BDHS monthly meeting, scheduled for 17th June 2022.
